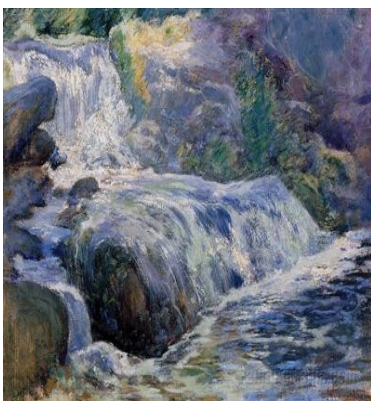

At home you can:

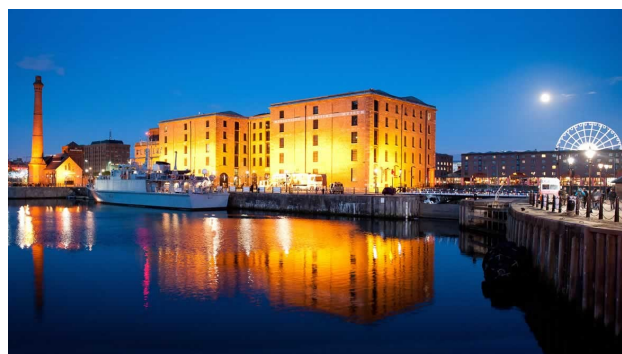
- Visit your local library to find out more about people and places in the UK.
