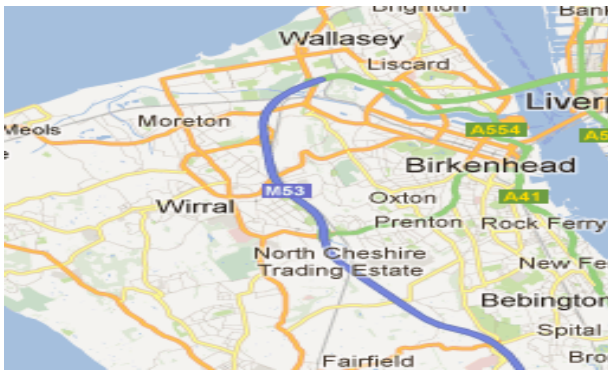

Download Google earth and have fun typing in your postcode.

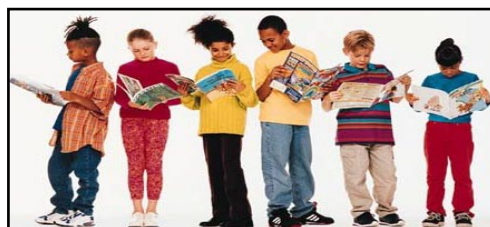
Use Google maps to look up places you have been or places people you know are from.
