

Y4 Multiplication Check

Thursday 17th November,

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you may be aware, there is a national statutory test for Y4 children called the 'Multiplication Tables Check' (MTC). The test will determine how well each child knows their multiplication tables up to 12×12 , which is the expected standard by the end of Year 4 and a vital factor in their understanding of other mathematical concepts.

The test will be administered in the Summer Term and will involve an online test of 25 multiplication questions. At the time of completing the test, children will be familiar with the structure and will be supported by their class teachers. The results of the test will help us to support the children as they progress through the Y5 and Y6 maths curriculum.

Over the coming months, class teachers will be working with the children to develop their recall and understanding of times table facts and to prepare them for their online assessment.

To support your child at home, class teachers will be providing paper-based activities in addition to children having access to their Times Table Rockstars account.
