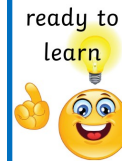

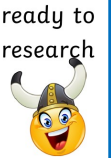


Complete one activity each week, in any order that you choose. You are welcome to do more. Homework activities are due in by Friday 24th May .

Growing

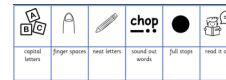


Physical Development
