Children <u>not wearing</u> the correct footwear to school will be asked to change into black pumps.






Each half term your child will receive a matrix of home learning activities to choose from.

Read Write Inc is our Phonics and early reading programme!





Read Write Inc is taught daily in groups based on children's stage of reading.

During the lessons, children learn to recognise a range of sounds. They practise blending to read words and segmenting to spell.


Most groups will bring home a matching Book Bag Book on Friday to read and enjoy at home.
