To keep our children safe we:

We train all our staff so they know they must report any safeguarding concerns immediately.

We give visitors a leaflet highlighting the school's code of conduct and how they should respond to child welfare concerns.

We have a code of conduct for all our staff and children.

We learn about E safety so we can be safe on line.

We teach children how to keep healthy and safe through our topics and assemblies and we have support from Childline and Barnardos,.

We do risk assessments of all our school activities and all staff follow our health and safety procedures.

Our Learning Mentor helps children and parents to be happy and feel safe in school.

We have circle time – a time for children to talk.

We have play leaders and school councillors and house captains to talk to, listen to and help other children.

Our Quiet Place helps everyone, children, families and staff to relax and deal with stress and upset.

Restorative Practice helps us to fix things.

We have lots of adults and children who will talk to, listen to and help our children and we have lots of adults in the playground at playtime to look after the children.

We have Family Learning programmes for all our parents.

Our parents group meets every Wednesday for coffee and a chat and to share school information.
