We recently asked the Local Authority and South Liverpool Learning Network to visit our school and review our safeguarding and inclusion practice to ensure that we are meeting statutory requirements and the needs of the children in our school.

We are very pleased to report that not only were statutory requirements found to be securely in place but practice was found to be exemplary.

- ✓ There was a calm and positive atmosphere within the school building and children were found to be very polite and well mannered.
