In recognition of our continued efforts in reading, we are embarking on the Reading Quality Mark accreditation process this year hosted by School Improvement Liverpool.

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The National Literacy Trust was commissioned by Liverpool's School Improvement Service to develop a Reading Quality Mark for primary and secondary schools to support schools in raising attainment levels. Qualitative impacts include improving children's and young people's participation in a range of reading activities and events, improved attitudes to reading for pleasure, providing motivation, increasing aspirations and supporting articulation. Schools have also reported significant increases in the level of home reading.

Everybody is on board with this exciting initiative and we welcome all parents and carers to join us too! Keep a look out for fun activities linked to reading like World Book Day, Parent and Carer Stay & Read sessions and Reading Buddies.
