Numbers Count is an intensive intervention programme that improves children's mathematical skills. Children work on a one-to-one basis with the Numbers Count Teacher with a focus on number. This includes counting, the number system, number facts and calculating. Each child is assessed at the start of the programme so that they can be given an individual learning programme tailored to their specific needs in number.

Numbers Count lessons are fun, interactive and personalised with a large focus on practical activities, helping to develop children's mathematical vocabulary and maths talk. The lessons take place in a special Numbers Count area, where there are plenty of mathematical resources to be used.

The Numbers Count teacher liaises with parents and shares their specialist knowledge with colleagues informally and through structured CPD, raising standards for all learners.
