Conversation Starter!

Next time you're shopping with your children ask them to find the cheapest and most expensive thing in a small shop or in one aisle of a supermarket.



- Why do the products cost that amount and who might buy them?
- Are there other versions of this item for different prices e.g. yogurts or chocolate? What would make your family buy the item?

Activity! As part of your child's learning experience you could compare the costs involved in, for example, making a pizza from scratch, buying a shop prepared pizza or ordering a take-away. You could also visit the local shop, or use supermarket websites, to explore different shopping offers, e.g. BOGOF, 3 for 2, 50% extra free etc. How do you decide if these are right for you?
