Please send into school:

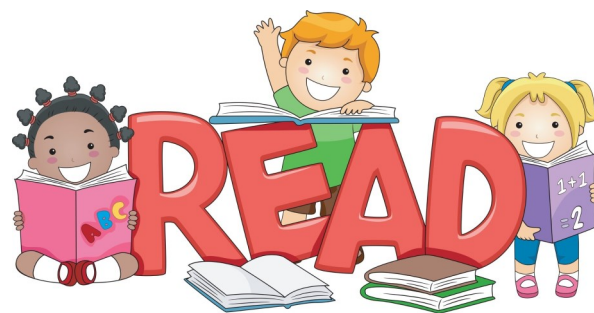
- Any books, leaflets, maps or facts you can find relating to Liverpool and its history.
