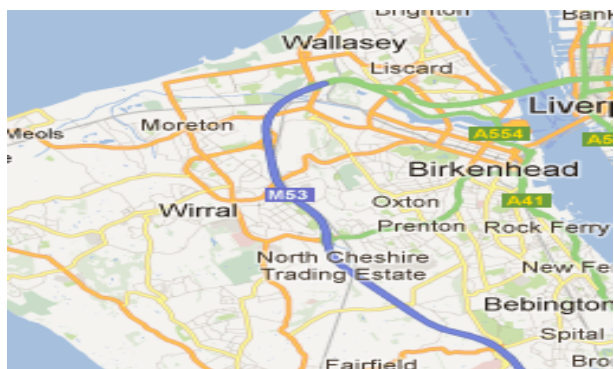

## At home you can:

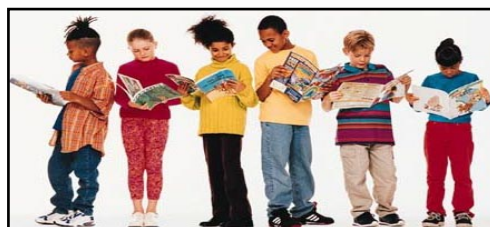
- Share any maps you have and ask questions about what they tell us.
