Talk about and look at pictures of London today—compare it with Liverpool.

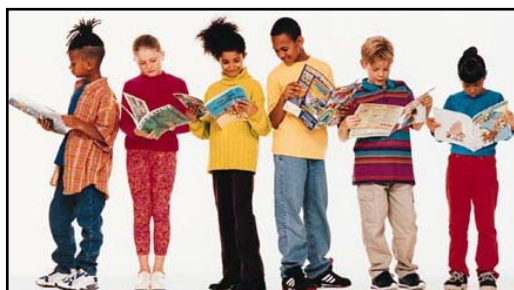
Read with your child for 15 minutes each night.
