



Wider Opening of Schools

Dear Parents,

We have been following Liverpool's recommended phased approach to the wider opening of our school to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all.

We are currently at **Phase 1** with children of key workers and vulnerable children currently attending school.

Today, following recent information about the virus and advice from local Public Health colleagues, Liverpool City Council has advised against any wider opening of schools to children on 15th June (Phase 2).

Therefore, we will **not** be admitting any other groups of children to school until further notice.

Key Worker children and vulnerable children should continue to attend.

We will contact you with a new date for Phase 2 as soon as it is advised safe to do so.

The safety and wellbeing of all will be at the heart of everything we do.
