



## Arrangements for Academic Year 2020 - 2021.

Dear Parents,

We are looking forward to all of the children returning to school in September. All children are now expected to return to school in September. Arrangements are set out below. As you would expect arrangements are very different to previous years. We have worked very hard to implement all the guidance provided. **COVID 19 Safe Procedures have been set. The procedures are attached. Please read very carefully.**

To help us make our school as safe as possible *everybody* has a part to play, COVID Safe Procedures *must* be followed. **By sending your child to school during this period, you are agreeing to follow our COVID Safe Procedures:**

On our return to school in September we shall focus our efforts initially on helping the children 'catch up' focussing upon the core subjects of English and Maths, basic skills from across the curriculum and PSHE (Personal, Social, and Health Education) and the wellbeing of all. **Your support will be vital** – children will need to establish school routines, read regularly at home, revise and learn spellings and times tables.

### Arrangements for beginning of term and school site

#### Foundation Stage

Families of Nursey and Reception children have received a separate letter setting out their arrangements for the beginning of term.

#### Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2

Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 children should return to school on **Wednesday, 2nd September 2020**. See start times below.

**Start and finish times will be staggered** to ensure the number of people on the school site at any one time is kept to a minimum. Please only enter site, if allowed, at time allocated to your child's year group/class:

- Nursery: 8.45am – 11.45am or 12.30pm – 3.30pm
- Year 1 and Year 3: 8.45am - 3.05pm
- Year 2 and Year 4: 8.55am - 3.15pm
- Reception and Year 5: 9.05am - 3.25pm
- Year 6 9.10am - 3.30pm

Staff will be positioned around the site to welcome and direct children and families.

**Entrance/exit to and from school will be controlled.** The procedures for this are set out in the COVID 19 Procedures document attached. Please note which entrance and exit should be used and other site controls for parents.

Reducing congestion around the site is essential and parents are asked that cars are parked away **at least 200m away** from school site. Please note restrictions in attached document. Thank you for your support.
