Dear Parents,

Public Health Alert!

I have been informed that there has been a significant increase in corona virus cases in Liverpool – particularly in Riverside, Allerton and Hunts Cross, Picton, Church, Tuebrook and Stoneycroft. This spike is taking place within the ‘**working age**’ population. (**Note – not children!**)

It is vital that we all play our part in preventing further spread of COVID-19 in our city.

To protect yourself and others, when you leave home you must:

- Stay at least 2 metres away from anyone you do not live with or who is not in your support bubble.
- Wash your hands with soap and water often, and as soon as you get home.
- Wear a face covering over your mouth and nose where social distancing is not possible outdoors and indoors and by law in shops and banks etc.
- Do not gathering in groups of more than 6 people inside and outside our home

And at school...

Remember keep your distance – 2m. Drop off/collect, leave swiftly – don’t stop to chat!



As previously stated, we are continually reviewing our procedures and will continue to do so.

We have now made some changes as a result of:

- discussions with **staff**
- speaking with **parents** - we have spoken with many parents over the last week – thank you for your suggestions and feedback.
- responding to changes from the **Government and Department for Education (DFE)**

Changes

1. All adults bringing children to school or collecting children should **wear face masks** on school site or when queuing and waiting at the school perimeter **from Monday, 14th September**.
2. All families with infant **and** junior siblings may enter school site via **All Saints Road** and arrive at school at the **earliest sibling's start time** and all children within that family may enter their classrooms at that time and will be supervised until their Year Group's start time.

Eg Sarah (Year 1) and Tom (Year 5) are brother and sister.

Sarah starts at 8.45am in Year 1. Tom in Year 5 arrives with Sarah and then walks across the playground to his classroom where he will be greeted by a member of staff and supervised until 9.05am.

(Junior children must walk through the playground to their classes on their own.)

3. **Junior children without infant siblings** enter via the junior entrance, Stockton Wood Road at their start time and will now walk directly to their classroom. Year 3 will continue to line up at the start of the day and will be met by their teacher at the entrance.
4. **Junior siblings** may arrive at the junior entrance on Stockton Wood Road at the **earliest sibling's start time** and may make their way to their classroom and where they will be supervised in class until their actual start time.

Eg Callum (Year 3) and David (Year 6) are brothers

Callum starts at 8.45am in Year 3. David arrives with Callum at the Key Stage 2 entrance and walks to his classroom where he will be greeted by a member of staff and supervised until his start time at 9.10am.

5. **Key Stage 2** families will be asked to queue and wait in **'zone areas'** for each **Year Group** marked on Stockton Wood Road to promote social distancing. Eg Year 3 Zone, Year 4 Zone etc. Please **do not wait outside our neighbours' houses** – signs will be set out to remind families to wait in the 'zone areas'.

We will continue to monitor and review these changes.

Children will be dismissed at home time at their allocated time.

Please ring school if you are unsure about these changes, need help or have any further difficulties and we will try our very best to help.
