Top tips!

- Please arrive at school **as close** to drop off and pickup time as possible.
 - Year 1 and Year 3: 8.45am - 3.05pm
 - Year 2 and Year 4: 8.55am - 3.15pm
 - Reception and Year 5: 9.05am - 3.25pm
 - Year 6 9.10am - 3.30pm
- Queue in one direction.
- Keep your distance – 2m!
- Parents must walk around to **Stockton Wood Road to drop off/collect Junior children.**
- Children must have a coat for school everyday day! Even if the sun is shining, the weather can change very quickly and the children will be taking part in outdoor learning every day.
