



COVID Safe Procedures @ Stockton Wood  
Update 3

Dear Parents,

As you know, our City is now under stricter controls. I have been informed that infection rates within our City place us within the top 3 areas nationally for infection rates hence the most recent announcements.

We have been working together incredibly well to control the virus within our community. Thank you again for your fantastic efforts. Our COVID Safe procedures can be found in full on our website and have previously been circulated – I have noted a few reminders below and some updates.

**Reminders and Updates**

- ✓ If a member of your household has **symptoms** a test should be taken and the children must isolate at home with their family and not attend school until test result is received.
- ✓ Children should only bring their **book bag and packed lunch box** (if needed) to school. (No rucksacks please.)
- ✓ Children should not bring their own **hand sanitiser** to school, we have plenty in school.
- ✓ Only **one** parent/carer should attend the school site to drop off and collect children from school to reduce numbers of people waiting and to support social distancing.
- ✓ A **childcare** bubble is where someone in **one** household can provide informal (i.e. unpaid and unregistered) childcare to a child aged 13 or under in another household. This must occur on an exclusive basis - always the same **two** households.
- ✓ Please ensure that we have the correct information stating who will collect your child from school. Families must inform school if any changes are made to **collection arrangements**.
- ✓ **Face coverings** must be worn when collecting and dropping off children at school (as directed by Public Health and Liverpool City Council).
- ✓ **Parking** – please do not park in Stockton Wood Road or Sutton Wood Road these roads are very narrow. Parked cars cause hazards for our children. Park away and walk to school.

**Thank you for helping to control the virus and keeping our community safe.**
