## ELECTION OF PARENT GOVERNORS

### Would you like to become more involved in our school community?

We are writing to invite nominations from parents to fill two vacancies for Parent Governors on our Governing Body.

An information leaflet is included which explains the role of a school governor. You may also like to talk to other parent governors about their role. They are Emma Paulson and Sam Fong.

The successful candidate will become a full member of the Governing Body and serve for four years with effect from December 2020.

To be eligible for election, your child must be a registered pupil of this school when the election takes place. Details of the election procedure and nomination form are enclosed.

Full Governing Body meetings of this school are usually held half termly at 4pm. Meetings usually last for approximately two hours. Committee meetings take place prior to each Full Governing Body meeting. Currently, our meetings take place via Zoom!

It is important that appropriate checks are made on anybody who will be working in a school to prevent unsuitable people from gaining access to children. Accordingly, new governors will be subject to an enhanced disclosure from the Disclosure and Barring Service in line with current safeguarding regulations issued by the Department for Education.

We look forward to receiving nominations for our Governing Body to support our school to continue to 'Lay the Foundations for Life' for all our pupils.
