



Code of Conduct for Remote Learning

Please follow our Code of Conduct so that live sessions are happy and safe – remember we should **behave the same way during our live sessions as we would in school and in our classrooms.**

A live session may involve using TEAMS or a Zoom call.

I understand that the following rules are designed to help keep me safe:

- I will only use school technology for school purposes as directed by my teacher.
- I will only take part in 'live' lessons if an adult knows that I am doing it.
- I will not share my passwords with anyone.
- I will be responsible for my behaviour and actions when using technology. This includes the resources I access and the language I use.
- I will not deliberately browse, download, upload or forward material that could be considered offensive or illegal. If I accidentally come across such material I will report it to my teacher or parent.
- I will not share resources or videos made by my teachers with anyone.
- I will not record or take photographs of my classmates or teachers during a live session.
- I will not share any school content on social media platforms.
- I understand that my teacher may record live sessions. This may be to monitor who has attended and to share with others who may have missed the live session.
- If these rules are not followed, school will contact my parent/carer.

Don't forget - when participating in a live session, this is an extension of your classroom and you should conduct yourself as you would in school using your best behaviour.

This includes:

- Be on time for your session.
- Be dressed ready for the day (no pyjamas).
- Sit in a room of your house that is quiet, public and free from distractions. Please do not use your bedroom.
- Listen carefully when your teacher is talking and follow instructions.
- Make sure you end the session when your teacher asks you to.
