



National Lockdown COVID Update 2

Dear Parents,

Thank you again for your amazing support for the National Lock down measures. For parents who may not have accessed our initial Lockdown letter (see website) I have included a summary of the Lock down requirements below:

The National Lockdown requires everyone to 'Stay Home'. It is now **illegal to leave home** except when necessary. I have provided a summary of **what you can and cannot do during the national lockdown** from the Government website for you below.

You must stay at home. The single most important action we can all take is to stay at home to protect the NHS and save lives.

Leaving home

You must not leave, or be outside of your home except where necessary.

You may leave the home to:

- shop for basic necessities, for you or a vulnerable person
- go to work, or provide voluntary or charitable services, if you cannot reasonably do so from home
- exercise with your household (or support bubble) or one other person, this should be limited to once per day, and you should not travel outside your local area.
- meet your [support bubble](#) or [childcare bubble](#) where necessary, but only if you are legally permitted to form one
- seek medical assistance or avoid injury, illness or risk of harm (including domestic abuse)
- attend education or childcare - for those eligible

Therefore, if children can stay safely at home, they should to limit the chance of the virus spreading.

Schools have been asked to make provision in school for critical workers and vulnerable children only until further notice.

If you are a critical worker and you are unable to make childcare arrangements for your child and require your child to attend school please email school with the following information:

- Child's name and class
- Parent/carer name and job/role
- Name and address of employer

Please note evidence of job/role will be required.

On receipt of information we will confirm your child's place and arrangements.

Places will be provided for critical workers' working days only.

Therefore, if you work Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday children should not attend school on Thursday and Friday. This is again to reduce transmission of the virus. If you do not need to leave home you should not!

Please only take up a school place if you really need to – if you can, you should stay home and stop the spread and transmission of the virus during this crucial time.

To replace our usual Parents' Evening at this time of year, Class teachers will be contacting parents by telephone over the next couple of weeks to discuss progress and achievements in school during the Autumn term. This will also be an opportunity to talk about home learning.
