Please find important letter attached from the Directors of Public Health and Children's Services stressing that communities must follow the lockdown rules even more carefully and stay home.

The single most important action we can all take is to **stay at home to protect the NHS and save lives.**

Only leave the house when absolutely necessary.

For example, go to the supermarket on your own, shop for your family and go home immediately.

In line with updated government guidance issued on Friday, even if you are a critical worker, if your child(ren) can remain at home rather than attend school, on some or all days, then they should. Please only use the offer of provision when it is crucial for you to undertake your critical role.

Critical Workers

Please provide **evidence of your job/role by showing your ID Badge** when you drop off children at school and **email evidence of the number of days that you are required to work each week to cw@stocktonwood.liverpool.sch.uk**. We are sorry to ask but it is vital that everyone follows the rules so that we can stop the transmission of the virus and move out of lock down as soon as possible.

As soon, as the infection rate is under control we can invite more children to return to school. Please stay home, keep your family safe and help reduce transmission of virus.
