This includes: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss, j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, ch, sh, th,.</p> <p>Get ready for phonics using the Phonics Sound Mat. Now your child is in the zone, follow along with the video.
