# Thursday Additional Notes

<p>Phonics</p>	<p>Every phonics lesson starts by revisiting all the letters we have learnt so far. This includes: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss, j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu.</p> <p>Phonics play has a race car game that will flash all the letters but if you want to make your own flash cards that would also be a great way to get 'in the phonics zone'.</p> <p>Now your child is in the zone, follow along with the video. The teacher is our friend and will let us know who's joining in ;)</p>
<p>Literacy</p>	<p>This is your first Narrative Strategy Sentence. Do not glue anything to the different coloured card as we will be using them once a week, with a different sentence.</p> <p>Using the sentence provided, can you cut the sentence up and place it on the colour card in the right order. <b>Who</b> is in the story? <b>What</b> happened? <b>Where</b> did it happen? <b>When</b> did it happen?</p> <p>Add actions to your story map.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Same as Tuesdays lesson. Make some number sentences again! Consolidate learning. Do not go above 20. Bribery always works well. If you do 5 number sentences you can go to play or have your favourite snack.</p>
