# Tuesday Additional Notes

<p>Phonics</p>	<p>Every phonics lesson starts by revisiting all the letters we have learnt so far. This includes: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss, j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, ch</p> <p>Ask your child to run their finger along the 'phonics sound mat' saying a sound for each letter. Give the school mobile a call if you need any clarification on letters and sounds.</p> <p>Now your child is in the zone, follow along with the video. <p>Literacy</p>	<p>It's time for you to become Authors! Change the penguin and the location from the story to an animal and place of your choice. If you did a story map (well done!) you can stick pieces of paper over the Penguin and location to whatever you have chosen to make up a story about. Here are some ideas that you can feel free to use but feel free to get creative about what you're interested in.</p> <p>The boy found a pig and took him to the farm          The boy found a dinosaur and took him to Jurassic World          The boy found a unicorn and took him to Fairy Land          The boy found an elephant and took him to the zoo/Asia/Africa.</p> <p>Can you retell the story? Maybe you can make a stick puppet using your drawing Sellotaped to a pen?</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Continue to explore Numicon.</p> <p>Put the Numicon into a 'feely bag' (Pillow case works fine). Can your child count the holes? Feel the shape? Does it feel bigger or smaller than the last shape?</p> <p>Can you order the numicon from 1-10? Can you make a tower of numicon starting with 10 at the bottom and make steps up. Once the tower is built and 1 is at the top. Slowly walk your finger down the tower pointing to correct piece of numicon each time "saying 1 more than 1 is 2", "1 more than 2 is 3", etc. Can your child repeat it after you?</p>
