Friday Additional Notes

<p>Phonics</p>	<p>On a Friday, we don't learn a new sound. We learn a tricky word! A tricky word is a word that can NOT be sounded out using phonics.</p> <p>Does your child know the tricky words we have learnt so far? On the phonics sound mat can your child say the tricky words:</p> <p><i>I, no, the, to, go, into, he, she</i></p> <p>Today's you have a new tricky word to learn. 'my'.</p> <p>Watch the video to recap the week and then play some games on Phonics Play, starting with Tricky Word Trucks.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=bZ5XfHKJS_M&list=PLuGr6z2H2KNGLy2Tckcy8Kk8u10mXgcmi&index=6</p>
<p>Literacy</p>	<p>Match the animal sound button words to the pictures! Remember to use your robot arms that we use in Phonics to help you sound out the words.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Time to make some number sentences using the Numicon. Suggested Strategy:</p> <p>E.g. Question 1) is $4+2=$. You get the 4 numicon, and then the 2 numicon and replicate the number sentence in the space provided.</p> <p></p> <p>Then <u>count</u> playdough balls / small objects / cheerios / grains of rice in to the Numicon holes.</p> <p>Read out the sentence aloud "4+2 *then you remove the numicon pieces and slide the playdough balls to after the equal sign. Then ask your child to count them to find the answer* =6!" Say the number sentence again. "4+2=6".</p>
