



COVID SAFE PROCEDURES @ STOCKTON WOOD UPDATE

Dear Parents,

As COVID restrictions are lifted and people are having more contacts COVID cases are rising. This means that there is an increased chance of children and staff being requested to self-isolate due to having a contact with a positive case out and about or at school. By working together, we can keep this to a minimum.

Self-Isolation

If your child has contact within 2 days of someone testing positive they will be asked to self-isolate. We operate a track and trace system in school so we are able to track contacts with in our school community. We will only ask those children and staff who have had contact with a positive case to self-isolate.

Self-testing

Everyone is encouraged to self-test regularly – this is known as the LFT test. If the LFT test is positive, a PCR test should be booked at a test centre. The **PCR test confirms whether someone is positive or not.**

Home Learning

When children self-isolate home learning will be supported – work packs and daily schedules will be provided, teachers and staff will support learning and wellbeing through Zoom/TEAM sessions, Oak Academy lessons, Twitter and telephone contact calls. The children should bring their completed work to school when they return. Please use the daily schedule to maintain school routines and learning at home.

COVID Procedures

Please be vigilant and continue to follow COVID safe procedures at home, at school and when 'out and about'. On entering the school site **face masks should be worn and when waiting to drop off or pick up please maintain 2m distance from each other.**
