



Catch Up Premium Report 2020 - 21

The government is providing funding to support children and young people to catch up. This includes a one-off universal catch-up premium for the 2020 to 2021 academic year to help schools to help pupils make up for lost teaching time.

The funding received by our school is £25 120 over 3 termly payments.

School will use this funding for specific activities to support our pupils to catch up for lost teaching and learning over the previous months, in line with the guidance on [curriculum expectations for the next academic year](#). Schools have the flexibility to spend their funding in the best way for their cohort and circumstances.

We will monitor the impact and effectiveness of the measures implemented throughout the course of the year using a range of strategies: Head Teacher Report to Governors; summary of analysis of pupil standards; findings from formative assessment methods; summary analysis of any end of year summative assessment.

The Education Endowment Fund (EEF) recommends a tiered approach to this support, ensuring that the following are considered:

- Quality First Teaching
- Targeted Support (for small groups of learners)
- Wider Strategies (for parents and carers to support learning)

Planned Expenditure

- Diagnostic Assessment resources to support quality first teaching and targeted intervention to support pupils catching up with English and Maths knowledge, skills and understanding, thus ensuring that they are well prepared for their next stage of education.
- Intervention lessons for Years 1-6 to support understanding and address gaps identified through diagnostic assessment – targeted groups, individuals
- SIL Catch Up training sessions for teachers and LSAs to support effective implementation of the intervention lessons for each year group
- Curriculum information for parents/carers of children in Years 1-6 to support learning, catch up and securing of basic skills.
- Purchase of resources and staff training to support catch up of writing knowledge, skills and understanding for pupils from Year 1 to Year 6. eg Literacy Counts
- Provision of universal and targeted therapeutic support through A Quiet Place Educational Therapeutics to secure mental health and wellbeing and to help children to be ready to learn.
