- Why is the rainforest in danger?

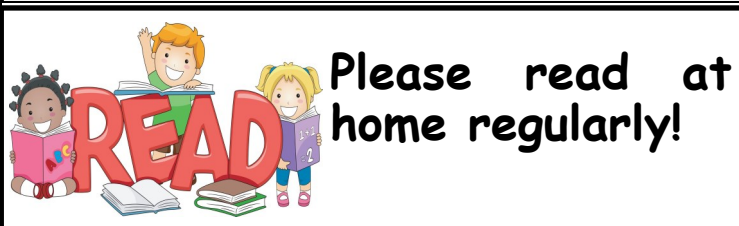
