Strike action by members of the National Education Union – Tuesday 28th February

I am writing to you about forthcoming strike action by the National Education Union (NEU), one of the main teaching trade unions.

How will strike action affect Stockton Wood Primary School?

To determine whether school can remain fully or partially open, a detailed risk assessment has been conducted. This considers the impact that the action will have on the health and safety of pupils, staff and visitors, and whether the school can run a full or amended curriculum, to determine whether it is possible to operate the school safely during the strike. Having completed the risk assessment, the **current** status (which is subject to change), is:

School will be open to pupils in the following classes: 1J, 1B, 2W, 3M and 4M

All other classes will be closed. Children will not be set work for this day.

Breakfast Club will be open on Tuesday 28th February for those children who are in classes 1J, 1B, 2W, 3M and 4M. There will be no clubs after school on Tuesday.

If your child is entitled to a 'Free School Meal', they are welcome to have a packed lunch on the day of the strike. Please contact the school office if you would like to take us up on this offer. This is only for children whose families have applied for free school meals and not all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 who receive a free meal as part of the universal offer. Children will bring their packed lunch home on Monday evening.

I understand that this situation is frustrating and ask that all members of the school community continue to treat each other with respect.
